GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Members should familiarize themselves with these rules & regulations prior to play

Behavior: Misbehavior, bad or foul language, abusive language, racquet abuse, ball or other equipment abuse and unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated. Likewise, coaching or audible derogatory remarks from sidelines during competition is unacceptable. Failure to comply with this code of behavior will result in disciplinary action up to and including membership suspension or revocation by the NOCTC Board.

Court Attire: Proper tennis court attire must be worn at all times while playing with NOCTC. Non-marking soled tennis shoes are required. Street clothes are not allowed to be worn while playing with NOCTC. Men must play with a shirt or tank-top worn correctly at all times. Clothes with offensive slogans or logos will not be allowed.

Membership fees: Membership renewal fees are due before January 1st. Membership will run on a calendar year from January 1 through December 31st of every year. All checks are payable to: NOCTC.

Competition Players: Players may not represent the North Orange County Tennis Club in any "outside" matches without prior written approval from the NOCTC Board of Directors.

Fullerton Tennis Center: While playing with NOCTC, players must also observe and follow the rules set by the Fullerton Tennis Center.

Inter-club matches: Players may not arrange for inter-club matches with the North Orange County Tennis Club without the prior written approval from the NOCTC Board of Directors.

Media contact: No NOCTC member may speak on behalf of the North Orange County Tennis Club to any media source including but not limited to television, news media, newspaper, print media of any kind, internet media. All inquiries for information should be directed to the club's President or Vice-President.

Internet / web: Derogatory comments posted on the internet (ex. Social networking web sites, web sites, etc.) about NOCTC, its Board of Directors or its members will not be tolerated. Doing such can lead to disciplinary action by the NOCTC Board up to and including suspension or revocation of membership.

Advertising / Offers: Any and all advertising or offers to the NOCTC membership must first be approved by the NOCTC Board of Directors. Written approval from the Board is required prior to distributing any offers, advertisements or solicitations of any type. You may submit your request to advertise by writing the Board directly or by emailing the Board via our web page – www.noctc.com. The reverse is also true, you may not promote or advertise NOCTC without permission from the NOCTC Board of Directors.

Rules & Regulations: These rules and regulations are a general list subject to change at any time and subject to interpretation by the North Orange County Tennis Club Board of Directors. It is up to the NOCTC members to familiarize themselves with these rules and keep up-to date on any changes.

Drugs: Illegal drug use will not be tolerated while playing with or representing NOCTC in any event or in any capacity. NOCTC has a zero tolerance for the use of illegal drugs. Members caught using illegal drugs while playing with NOCTC or representing NOCTC will have their membership immediately revoked and their name forwarded to the appropriate law enforcement authority.

Group play: NOCTC members gather on Friday nights and Saturday afternoons for group play in the mixed doubles format. We begin play at 7:00pm on Friday nights and 4:00pm on Saturday afternoons (weather permitting). There is a fee for playing (check web site for current fees) and we play three (3) timed sets which last approximately 40-45 minutes. We ask that you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to start time as we do warm up prior to play. NOCTC provides practice balls and game balls for the members. We make every attempt to keep the teams mixed and doubles, depending on attendance we may not always be able to have all teams mixed or doubles. We ask that you plan on playing the entire three (3) sets, if you must leave early please notify the play coordinator on your arrival so the appropriate arrangements can be made. LEAVING EARLY IS STRONGLY DISCOURAGED.
